6	A BILL to require the Commonwealth Transportation Board to establish a Washington Bypass
7	transportation corridor.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. § 1. The Commonwealth Transportation Board shall establish, consistent with the provisions of
10	Chapter 670 of the Acts of Assembly of 2009, a Washington Bypass transportation corridor in order to
11	facilitate and prioritize the construction of a limited access highway to expedite the nonstop passage of
12	traffic through the Washington metropolitan area. Such bypass shall be a limited access highway with
13	access only at interstates, no more than three primary highways, and access to Washington Dulles
14	International Airport. No such bypass shall be constructed unless and until a corresponding facility has
15	been constructed or is in progress in the State of Maryland and is available to be linked to the Virginia
	facility. Such a bypass will be a toll facility. If deemed appropriate by the Commonwealth
	Transportation Board, such project may be undertaken pursuant to the Public-Private Transportation
	Act of 1995 (§ 56-556 et seq.) of the Code of Virginia.
