7. **Budget Amendment Necessary:** Yes. The cost of this legislation will be reflected in increased employer contribution rates for FY11. This will increase the Unfunded Accrued Liability (UAL) by \$454,340,000 for state employees, \$1,010,761,000 for teachers and \$244,094,000 for Localities (non hazardous duty). In addition, the cost of this legislation will decrease the funded ratio of these plans.
