1.	Title: Disability services boards; eliminates requirement that localities establishes.						

5. Summary: Disability services boards. Eliminates the requirement that localities establish local disability services boards and makes establishment of local disability services boards optional for localities. The bill amends the list of activities that a local disability services board may perform and abolishes the Disability Services Council and the Rehabilitative Services Incentive Fund, but provides that localities may establish a local fund for the purposes previously served by the Rehabilitative Services Incentive Fund.

7. Budget Amendment Necessary: None

- 8. Fiscal Implications: None. This bill would modify the code to reflect an approved 2009 budget action. The approved action redirected funding from the Disability Service Boards (DSB) to the Vocational Rehabilitation program at the Department of Rehabilitative Services. Additionally, the 2009 budget action eliminated the requirement for localities to establish a DSB, modified the list of activities that a local disability services board may perform, and abolishes the Disability Services Council and the Rehabilitative Services Incentive Fund, but provides that localities may establish a local fund for the purposes previously served by the Rehabilitative Services Incentive Fund. Authority to make these changes is currently in the Appropriation Act.
