**4. Title:** Virginia Commission on Youth; review and report on the use of seclusion and restraint in schools.

**5. Summary:** The Conference substitute bill requires the Virginia Commission on Youth, in consultation with the Department of Education and the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services, to review (i) statewide policies and regulations related to seclusion and restraint in public and private elementary and secondary schools and (ii) methods used in other states to reduce and eliminate the use of seclusion and restraint in public and private elementary and secondary schools. The bill requires the Commission to make recommendations for the modernization of Virginia's policies and regulations and to submit these recommendations no later than November 30, 2014. The Commission is to report its findings to the Governor and the 2015 Regular Session of the General Assembly.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The Virginia Commission on Youth expects that any fiscal impact of the bill can be absorbed within the agency's existing budget.
