5. Summary: The proposed legislation would require the tie breaker of any elected school board to be elected in the same manner as the members of the school board. Currently tie breakers for elected school boards are appointed by the school board.

8. Fiscal Implications: The bill would require the creation of a new member of elected school boards for the purposes of breaking ties. The bill may result in minimal added cost for local school boards. The bill will not impact state finances.
