2. **Patron:** Cole

3. **Committee:** Education and Health

4. **Title:** Diabetes; care of students who have been diagnosed.

5. **Summary:** The proposed legislation would require local school boards to permit students with diabetes to carry and use supplies and self-check their own blood glucose levels on a school bus, on school property, and at a school-sponsored activity. The bill also requires that by July 1, 2015, the Department of Education (DOE) is to review and update its manual on training requirements for school personnel on diabetes care.

6. **Budget Amendment Necessary:** None.

7. **Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Preliminary. See Item 8.

8. **Fiscal Implications:** The bill requires local school divisions to permit diabetic students to provide for their own diabetes care. Those requirements will have no state fiscal impact. Any impact to DOE related to the amending of its training manual can be absorbed within existing resources.
