2. Patron: Norment

3. Committee: Passed both houses

4. Title: Academic transcript documentation of suspension, dismissal, withdrawals for sex offences.

5. Summary: Requires the registrar or the other employee, office, or department that is responsible for maintaining student academic records of each public institution of higher education or private institution of higher education eligible for Tuition Assistance Grants or to receive Virginia College Building Authority financing, to include a prominent notation on the transcript of each student who has been suspended, permanently dismissed, or who withdrew from the institution while under investigation for a violation of the institution's code, rules or standards of conduct. The legislation also requires that each student receive notification of these provisions, and that each institution adopt procedures for the removal of such notation from students' records who are subsequently found not to have violated rules, code, or standards of conduct. The legislation provides for circumstances in which the notation can be removed, and exempts Virginia Military Institute from its provisions.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that any administrative efforts required to address the provisions of this legislation can be accommodated within existing resources of the higher education institutions.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Virginia public institutions of higher education and private institutions eligible for Tuition Assistance Grants or to receive Virginia College Building Authority financing, except for Virginia Military Institute.
