Any locality imposing a fee relating to stormwater may make funds available for ormwater maintenance dredging, including at the point of discharge, where stormwater has ntributed to the deposition of sediment in state waters. However, any locality in the Lynnhaven wer watershed shall use such stormwater fee for dredging back to the point of discharge the tom of any river in which stormwater has contributed to the deposition of sediment.
